What a year! What an understatement! Around the world and in Minnesota, COVID-19 took its toll. And on May 25, around 8:15 p.m., the Twin Cities metro area was turned upside down. Of course I am speaking of the death of George Floyd. The ensuing peaceful demonstrations and the riots had the eyes of the world riveted on Minneapolis and St. Paul with pundits and politicians speaking out and waves of social media commentary.

Forty Days for Life Twin Cities began its fall campaign on September 23 at Planned Parenthood's (PP) upper mid-

Second New Abortion Site this Year in Twin Cities

PP Starts Killing in Uptown Minneapolis

On November 19, just four months after Planned Parenthood North Central States (PP) started committing chemical abortions at its new Brooklyn Park, Minn. location, it began doing abortions in its new \$14.4 million building in the Uptown area of Minneapolis. Abortions at both locations are being done through a webcam process just as PP has been doing in Rochester, Minn. since 2010.

In a webcam abortion, the woman goes to the "satellite" PP location where she has an ultrasound and lab tests and then speaks through a Skype-type interface to the abortionist located at PP's headquarters in St. Paul. We are very concerned that PP may be planning this scheme for other locations in Minnesota. Webcam abortions are banned in South Dakota

(and 19 other states), which is why PP tried to open a webcam abortion center in Luverne (far southwestern Minnesota) this past spring before being stopped by

Pro-Life Action Ministries and the strong pro-life people in Luverne. The PP in

Who Won the Elections?

The major media were quick to “call” the presidential election for Joe Biden, as if they are the ones who decide the next president. Ever hear of a President Dewey? Meanwhile, President Donald Trump and many of his supporters have continued to hold onto claims of election fraud that will overturn the results in key states and give Trump a victory. But let’s face the reality, President Trump’s election fraud efforts are a longshot.

The presidential election wasn’t the only election on November 3. All seats in the House of Representatives and one-third of the Senate seats were up for a vote on the federal level. And there were a myriad of races in the various states, counties, municipalities and other election districts.

On the federal level, Democrats were set to increase their majority by 15 – 20 seats in the House of Representatives. Instead, Republicans may have gained as many as 12 seats, seriously narrowing the Democrat (and, therefore pro-abortion) majority for the next Congress. Prior to the election, the Senate was to fall to the Democrats. Currently, with the two Independent seats that almost always vote with the Democrats, the Senate remains in a 50-48 seat majority with Republicans, with both Senate seats in Georgia in a runoff election set for January 5. If either of those Senate seats remain Republican, their narrow majority will continue. (A 50-50 Senate has all tie breakers decided by the Vice-President.)

So, who won the elections? If Biden holds on to become president, then I certainly know who lost the elections: the unborn.

God is greater than any election, or president, or nation. We serve Him and do our work because of Him. Our presence on the sidewalks will continue to be used by God to save lives. . . . It is in adversity that we are refined and grow, as long as we are willing to take courageous action!

Biden is set to rescind all the pro-life executive orders and efforts of President Trump. U.S. foreign aid money will begin to be used to kill unborn children and promote the killing of the unborn. Planned Parenthood would again receive Title X money. Biden also is expected to repeal a Trump executive order that granted relief to charities like the Little Sisters of the Poor. Biden would once again force them to follow the Affordable Care Act contraception mandate, which includes drugs that may cause abortions. He will also re-issue Obama-era guidance rescinded by the Trump administration

that states can’t defund Planned Parenthood from their Medicaid programs.

Biden is also expected to rescind a Trump rule that allows health workers to refuse to provide or participate in abortions on moral or religious grounds. Biden may also remove a requirement issued in 2011 that abortion pills only be prescribed in person at specific health care settings (see page 3). Biden is expected to seek to rescind the Hyde Amendment that has long kept our federal tax dollars from paying for most abortions. A windfall of hundreds of millions of our tax dollars will go to the billion-dollar-plus abortion industry. The net result: an ingraining of abortion deeper

Beware Rural Minnesotans: **Mobile Abortion Unit Coming to Your Community?**

A former Planned Parenthood director from Austin, Texas, Dr. Julie Amaon, is spearheading an effort to establish a mobile abortion unit which would travel the rural areas of Minnesota, especially in the western part of the state and among immigrant populations. This traveling abortion unit would dispense the “abortion pill” (chemical abortions using mifepristone [formerly called RU 486] and misoprostol). This is the type of abortion portrayed in the movie “Unplanned”.

Called “Just the Pill,” the organization’s stated mission is to “expand access to sexual and reproductive healthcare in rural Minnesota.” On its page for the recent fundraising day organized by GiveMN.org, it stated, “We recognize the importance of understanding and reducing obstacles presented by language, geographic location and poverty.”

Amaon, who received her Minnesota medical license in 2019 (see page 6), is the medical director of Just the Pill. In September she started dispensing the abortion pill through the mail from her office in Minneapolis. Just the Pill and similar abortion organizations in other parts of the country were able to do this because in July U.S. District Judge



Six weeks after conception. The abortion pill is used to kill babies up to several weeks beyond this point in the pregnancy.

Theodore Chuang (of Maryland), citing the COVID-19 pandemic, issued a nationwide injunction blocking the FDA’s “Risk Evaluation and Mitigation Strategies” (REMS) for the abortion pill, thereby NOT requiring an in-person clinic

visit prior to a chemical abortion. Just the Pill says it “is taking advantage of the tremendous opportunity that this decision presents.” The Trump Administration appealed Judge Chuang’s decision (and 11 states filed an *amicus brief* supporting the appeal). On October 8, the U.S. Supreme Court essentially put the appeal on hold, with Justices Samuel Alito and Clarence Thomas issuing a strong dissent, severely criticizing Judge Chuang’s decision. In addition, pro-life leaders have written to FDA director, Dr. Stephen Hahn, urging that the abortion pill be removed from the market.

Back to Just the Pill and its plans beyond its current mailed abortion pills. On its GiveMN.org page, its stated vision is to “bring abortion care, birth control and STI treatment to rural Minnesota using a mobile clinic. In addition, with planned routes near Minnesota’s western border, we anticipate serving residents of North and South Dakota, where abortion restrictions are severe.”

west flagship abortuary in St. Paul. Around the corner and up the street from PP were burned-out hulks of buildings now boarded up from the riots. Even though it was months after the death of George Floyd, I received calls from concerned 40 Days volunteers wondering if it was safe to go out and pray. It was interesting that most of these callers were calling not because *they* were reluctant to come out, but because of the concern of family and friends. We assured them to come out and pray during 40 Days for Life and all would be well – and so it was.

This was one of our strongest 40 Days for Life campaigns. But as a coordinator for 13 campaigns so far, it was frustrating, for a good reason. This year, due to the elections and the civil unrest, more people than ever were encouraged to participate. The comment, “I had to do something,” resonated with a resounding “fear not.”

The frustration? More participants showed up to pray “spontaneously” without registering online or using the online calendar! New churches and individuals who had never been at an abortuary felt they were called to the sidewalk for such a time as this. It reminded me of the surge of prayer supporters who “showed up” after the movie “Unplanned” was released. This fall’s 40 Days also received a blessing of two babies saved from PP!

Abortions Coming to Rural Minnesota? (from page 3)

A meme posted on this page shows a drawing of a pink mobile unit surrounded by hearts and including a banner stating, "Abortion is Normal!" On its website, Just the Pill announced that they will also be offering hormone "therapy" for those confused about their gender. According to an October 2, 2020 article in the now-defunct *City Pages*, Just the Pill has received funding from Gender Justice (which is suing Minnesota to get rid of our pro-life regulations) and NARAL.

Although the national abortion rate has declined by 8 percent from 2014, the use of the abortion pill now accounts for 39 percent of abortions -- up from 29 percent in 2014. Before the REMS were lifted by Judge Chuang, the typical abortion pill process included an ultrasound to determine the age of the baby and to rule out an ectopic pregnancy. Rh testing was done to help prevent problems with subsequent children. Even so, 24 maternal deaths and more than 4,000 other adverse reactions (nearly half of which were serious or even life-threatening) caused by the abortion pill have been reported by the manufacturer of mifepristone to the FDA. However, it is very likely that many more adverse reactions go unreported.

After the United Kingdom (UK) allowed for the abortion pill to be sent via

mail and taken at home earlier this year, two women died, including one who developed sepsis and another who was found dead in her home after beginning the abortion pill process the day before. A leaked e-mail from the National Health Service also mentions "women attending ED (emergency departments) related to the process through ruptured ectopics, major resuscitation for major haemorrhage, and the delivery of infants who are up to 30 weeks gestation."

Also, it was revealed that UK police were investigating the possible murder of a baby apparently born alive after the mother took the abortion drugs late in the pregnancy. Mailed abortion pills could also be obtained, perhaps by a sexual abuser or angry boyfriend or parent, and

used to coerce or trick women into unwittingly aborting their babies.

Just the Pill is not a Planned Parenthood (PP) project, but that doesn't mean that the nation's largest abortion provider is not involved in similar schemes. PP in St. Paul is involved in a mail-out chemical abortion research project called "Tel-Abortion" which began even before the FDA regulations were lifted.

If Just the Pill's mobile unit becomes operational (pray that it doesn't!), the lives of babies will be destroyed, and the spiritual and physical lives of women in rural Minnesota will be put at risk. Please stay alert to the possibility of abortion coming to your community either via this mobile unit or PP webcam abortions (see page 1).

COVID-19 Vaccines

Vaccines are sometimes designed, produced and/or tested using cell lines originally derived from the tissue of aborted babies. There is some controversy among pro-lifers regarding the new COVID-19 vaccines manufactured by Pfizer and Moderna as to which ones are ethically produced and tested. We recommend that you judge for yourself by going to the websites of the Charlotte Lozier Institute (www.lozierinstitute.org), Children of God for Life (www.cogforlife.org) and the Personhood Alliance (www.personhood.org), three pro-life organizations which have done extensive research into these vaccines. All three organizations agree that we must speak up and demand ethically-produced vaccines (and other drugs).

Thanksgiving Baby Saved!

The day before Thanksgiving a vehicle rolled into the St. Paul Planned Parenthood (PP) slowing for a moment as if to take literature but then going on into the parking lot. Fewer employees than normal were at PP that morning, so the couple parked in a spot usually filled very early. But this was good for me calling out to the woman as she had to walk further to the entrance. She looked up at me twice and hesitated once (even turning back toward the vehicle momentarily) before continuing into PP. About twenty minutes later, the couple came driving out with the passenger window down, stopping to talk to me. They appeared to be African nationals (and Muslim). The man spoke in his thick accent. At first I wasn't understanding what was being said. Then it became clear to me. He was telling me that they decided not to abort because of what they

saw (prayer supporters and me) as they drove in and what she heard me call out about willing to help. I gave them our literature and Abria card (the nearby pregnancy help center) and assured them of the free help available. She clearly had been crying (bloodshot eyes) but still managed a smile. I told them that they can handle their precious new baby with God's help, our help and each other, with which they readily agreed.

Babies Saved in Central Florida!

In mid-October, a precious life was saved at the AWHC abortuary! This baby was 5 months along in the womb. Five months! It was later-term day and a mother had accompanied her daughter to the mill to have an abortion. When they arrived, they were greeted by sidewalk counselors and Christians praying and worshiping the Lord but they refused offers of help, and walked inside this place of death. Later on in the day though, this mother and daughter walked out of the killing center and got into their

car and yelled, "We chose LIFE!" At that, the counselors were so thankful and excited, and began to speak with them, handing them information, while one counselor asked, "What made you change your mind?" The mother answered, "We just couldn't do it!" The counselors then told them that they could go next door to the pregnancy center and even get an ultrasound which they did and on the way out, they stopped to show the sidewalk counselors the ultrasound picture of this precious baby who had been rescued from the barbaric act of abortion. They looked at the counselors and said, "You all are wonderful; thank you for what you are doing and being here." Hallelujah for HE is great and greatly to be praised!

Then, in November, we had a baby saved at the OWC abortuary in Orlando! Here is the report: One of the sidewalk counselors continued to reach out with help to an abortion-bound woman and her friend. This went on and on throughout the morning with him talking with her on and off for a while. Finally she came out, got in her car and drove out, but not without stopping, getting out of the car, giving him a big hug and telling him she had changed her mind! He reported that he had been emphasizing to her that we would like to help her. Thank you Jesus!

He was there for a heart check, but Geri told him about the babies killed inside. He went in anyway, but soon came out and left, saying that he couldn't do business there because of the abortions! Praise God for this man acting on his convictions, and praise God for Geri's presence and witness!

nearby Sioux Falls, S.D. had stopped doing abortions during the pandemic before resuming its killing in September. We believe many babies might have been saved over the spring and summer due to the temporary closure of this location, the only abortion mill in S.D.

Currently, chemical abortions are scheduled from 8:30-3:45 on Thursdays at the Uptown location (1200 Lagoon Ave., Minneapolis). Free parking is available nearby. A few of us have started sidewalk counseling there on a regular basis and we feel safe. Besides good opportunities to speak with the PP clients, there are opportunities to give literature to and speak with passersby.

Because we need a minimum of two sidewalk counselors during each shift to cover the two entrances, we could use

your help there to save lives! Prayer supporters and those holding signs would also be very helpful as there are *many* spots to stand where the clients can see you, both from the parking lot and from inside the building. If you can help every Thursday, one or two Thursdays a month or an occasional Thursday, please contact Sidewalk Counseling Coordinator, Bill Kelly, at 612-599-5733 or william.kelly@plam.org

If you live outside the Twin Cities area, please keep us in prayer with this vital work. By God's grace, we need to thwart this expansion of abortion and PP itself. If you have a PP facility in your town that currently does not kill unborn babies, stay alert to what is going on. Perhaps your efforts could help prevent a PP webcam abortion site from coming to your community!

Determined Not to Talk to the "Protestors"

A young woman pulled into the St. Paul Planned Parenthood (PP) driveway and

stopped as I approached. I gave her the literature, and then asked if she was there for an abortion. Her eyes teared up and I said, "You do not want to kill your baby." She shook her head no. I told her about Abria and asked if I could take her there. She said "Yes," and added, "I just cannot do it." On the way there, she told me more about her situation – job, other children, and the fact that the father of the baby did not know she was at PP and that he would not want her to abort. She added that she knew we pro-lifers would

(*Editor's note – On its website for abortion clients, PP encourages them "to avoid interaction" with the "protestors" outside.*) She had determined not to stop and talk to us, so I asked her why she did stop. Again she said, "I just cannot do this." I called Abria when we arrived and they came to the door and took her in. Later I returned to Abria and left a note with my name and number and a baby blanket on her windshield. She has a very sweet and tender, but scared, heart. Pray for her. Thank you.

Julie Amaon, M.D., 44, is the medical director of Just the Pill (see page 3). Previously she was the director of a Planned Parenthood abortion center in Austin, Texas, and decided to go to medical school in 2012 so there would be more abortionists in that state.

Her family medicine residency program at the University of Minnesota Medical Center trained everyone studying family medicine in abortion (with an opt-out available). As a family practice physician, Amaon hopes to be able to do abortions, along with treating sinus infections, prenatal care, etc. Abortion is "just part of regular primary care for me," she told the *City Pages* (October 2, 2020).

Please pray for Amaon that she would recognize that unborn children are part of the family too and deserve to be treated with respect instead of being killed. Pray that she would repent, turn her life over to Christ, and provide life-affirming healthcare to all.

Is Your Doctor Involved in Abortions?

Does Your Doctor Prescribe Abortifacient Birth Control?

Ask your doctor if he/she does abortions or refers for them, or prescribes abortifacients such as the Pill, Ortho Evra (the "patch"), Depo-Provera (the "shot"), Nuva-Ring, the "morning-after pill," implants, or the IUD. All these methods (and others) can cause very early abortions by thinning the lining of the uterus so that if breakthrough ovulation occurs (which is possible) and a new life is conceived, the young human being may not be able to attach to the uterine lining and therefore he or she dies.
