

## Sidewalk Counselor Wins Case Against Rocky Rococo's for Illegal Tow

My car was illegally towed on August 6 of last year by a manager of Rocky Rococo's next door to Planned Parenthood (PP) in Brooklyn Park, Minn. The lot from which it was towed did not belong to the restaurant nor to PP. Earlier this year, a Hennepin County Conciliation Court referee ruled in my favor and ordered the manager, James Agostino, and the owner of that Rocky Rococo's to reimburse me.

We suspect that PP workers may have instigated this incident. An aggressive PP escort was there at the time, and later that day and the next day, she taunted me about my car being towed. And just recently, the head of PP security in the Twin Cities area, Kelli Williams, said to me, "We'll tow your car again."

I have been sidewalk counseling at that PP weekly since it started doing abortions in July 2020. I had only parked in the next door Aldi's lot on a few occasions, but was never told by Aldi's not to park there. Other sidewalk counselors had routinely parked there and there was never an incident. On that particular August day, I parked in the far corner of Aldi's large lot because I had some materials to give to another sidewalk counselor. The tree line separating Aldi's lot from Rocky Rococo's lot blocked my view while I was sidewalk counseling so I didn't notice my car being towed. (Agostino never warned me.) Several prayer supporters were parked there that day, but only my car was towed, so it appears my car was targeted.

Concerned about what had happened, two of my co-workers, Brian Gibson and Brian Walker, went to Rocky Rococo's the next week to ask Agostino to reimburse me for the tow cost. Agostino adamantly refused, tried to grab Brian Gibson's phone when he noticed that

Brian was recording the conversation, then slammed the door shut and called the police. A few weeks later, I sent a certified letter to Stacey Agostino of the family corporation, SDJJ Agostino, LLC, which owns that particular Rocky Rococo's, requesting reimbursement. (We believe Stacey is James' mother.) The certified letter was signed for by James but I received no response from Stacey.

So then I decided to file a lawsuit against Agostino and the corporation in order for justice to be served and to help

protect our volunteers from being targeted by this kind of action. The hearing was held on January 11 by Zoom. Neither James nor a representative of the corporation showed up to defend themselves. The judicial referee ordered the defendants to pay me \$231.60 for the tow and \$70 for the court filing cost. The decision was stayed to allow for appeals until February 4, at which time the judgment became final.

It has been more than two months since the judgment and I have not yet received payment from the defendants.

### Jericho March Closing



Every year, we conduct a seven-day Jericho March to conclude our 40 Days for Life Lenten Campaign. This year about 100 people participated on the seventh day, April 10, walking around the St. Paul Planned Parenthood six times in silent prayer, the seventh time with praises to God, and ending in front with seven rounds of loud acclamations to God. Two babies were saved there during this 40 Days Lenten Campaign, one on the very first day!

# Aborted Babies Uncovered in D.C. Show Evidence of Crimes, Officials Stalling Investigation

Officials with the Washington, D.C. city government, and the U.S. Department of Justice apparently are not interested in determining if crimes were committed at an abortion center in Washington after two pro-lifers obtained the bodies of 115 aborted children from a waste hauler outside the mill in late March. All of these killings were evil, but in the case of five of these children, the killings may have been illegal as well.

The injuries sustained by some of these children indicate they were killed in violation of the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban or the Born-Alive Infant Protection Act, which would be federal crimes. Within a day after receiving them from the pro-lifers, the D.C. Medical Examiner announced that autopsies would not be done. But autopsies are needed to determine if the babies were born alive and left to die or if they were killed by the partial-birth abortion method, whereby the baby is killed as it is being delivered.

The pro-lifers, Terrisa Bukovinac and Lauren Handy of the Progressive Anti-Abortion Uprising (PAAU), were outside the Washington Surgi-Center on March 25 when they noticed boxes being loaded into a Curtis Bay Medical Waste Services truck. They asked the driver if he knew what was in the boxes and when he said no, Terrisa said, “dead babies.” He was shocked and then Terrisa and Lauren asked if they could have one of the boxes. He agreed when they said they wanted to bury the babies.

They took the box to Lauren’s home and in what Terrisa described as a “completely soul-crushing experience,” they opened the boxes (video-taping while doing so) and discovered 115 bodies, including the baby shown here, a boy they named Christopher X. Another baby, Phoenix, was still in the amniotic sac, indicating he or she might have been born alive and left to die. Within days, all the babies were named and a funeral Mass for unbaptized children was held. A Catholic priest took the 110 smaller

babies and buried them in a private grave.

Terissa and Lauren, on the advice of a pro-life attorney, arranged for the D.C. Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) to pick up the five older bodies on March 30. From the beginning, Terissa and Lauren wanted to provide a dignified burial to all these babies and so they are requesting the five babies be returned for burial, but the Medical Examiner still has possession of them.

Several Republican members of Congress have written to D.C. Mayor Muriel Bowser and the MPD, asking for an investigation into these babies’ deaths. Bowser responded by accusing Lauren of “tampering with fetal remains,” saying that is potentially a violation of federal law. Earlier, dozens of congressional leaders had demanded the U.S. Department of Justice do an investigation. The abortionist at Washington Surgi-Center, Cesare Santangelo, was caught on undercover video by investigators from Live Action in 2013, in essence admitting that he doesn’t provide care to a baby who survives an abortion. Obviously, he is the one who needs to be charged in this case.

## Lauren and Others Indicted

In another show of opposition to the cause of life, Lauren and 8 others were arrested on March 30 (the same day the bodies were retrieved by the police) for a pro-life “rescue” at the Washington Surgi-Center on October 22, 2020. Lauren said, “We entered the clinic and sought to love the women who were already there for their abortion procedures. We tried to offer them help so they would choose life. We non-violently defended the unborn who were about to be exterminated – the innocent, the most vulnerable, killed in horrific acts of violence and treated as so much trash.”

The nine rescuers were initially charged with a D.C. trespass ordinance and were waiting for a court appearance to be scheduled. However, unbeknownst to them, Biden’s Department of Justice convened a grand jury and the indictment was “unsealed” on March 30.

So those who tried to prevent the killing of babies like those recently uncovered are being charged with federal crimes (conspiracy to obstruct civil rights and violating the Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances [FACE] Act) while abortionist Santangelo is not being charged with any crime, at least not yet.

Terrisa, the founder of PAAU and a self-described atheist and leftist, said, “We cannot build a better world on a pile of murdered children. That’s not progress. Real progress is protecting the vulnerable from exploitation from people like Santangelo who are the true villains here.”

## Aborted Babies into Electricity

Finally, another aspect to this story indicates the depths our country has sunk to in regards to abortion. Curtis Bay, the medical waste disposal company that picks up the bodies from the Washington Surgi-Center and other abortion mills, proudly states on its website that it burns medical waste and turns it into energy, meaning that the bodies of aborted babies are being converted into electricity for residents of the Baltimore area! This is demonic. Lord, help us!

# PP Increases Tax-Funded Abortions to New Record High in Minn.

*Editor's note — This article is condensed from a March 23 press release from Minnesota Citizens Concerned for Life (MCCL)*

Planned Parenthood (PP) performed 23 percent more tax-funded abortions in Minnesota in 2020, according to a report just released by the Minnesota Department of Human Services. Overall, taxpayers reimbursed abortion practitioners just over \$1 million for 4,410 abortions during the 2020 pandemic year.

“The pattern is clear: Planned Parenthood does more abortions year after year after year,” says MCCL Executive Director Scott Fischbach. “The group exploits the availability of taxpayer Medicaid dollars to push its numbers and revenue up. The result is that more unborn children die and more low-income women are left without the real solutions they need. And taxpayers are forced to fund all of it.

The 2020 tax-funded abortion total was a marginal drop from

fearful, but that abortion was not the answer for her precious miracle baby. We asked about the father and how he felt about it, and she told us that her husband was happy and did not want her to have the abortion.

She continued to look at the brochure we had given her, and then suddenly lifted her head, looked at us, and said, "I've changed my mind, I'm not going to do this!" At that moment joy fell upon her and she smiled at us!

Sandra, one of the other sidewalk counselors, gave her a cap and booties set, and she was so thankful for this little gift of love. We exchanged phone numbers and made plans to meet for lunch. GLORY! What a miracle!

God intervened, and used the worship of HIS people, the preaching of the gospel, the prayers of HIS saints, and offers of help to reach deep down inside this woman, to convict her heart of what she had originally planned. Instead of death and destruction, life prevailed, and we thank God for HIS great love and mercy.

### Second Baby Saved!

During our last “Jesus Loves the Little Children” Day, where moms and dads bring their children out to sing, pray, do sidewalk chalk art, speak up for the

babies being led to the slaughter, and try to rescue babies, A BABY WAS SAVED!

This happened at the AWHC abortuary in Altamonte Springs, and even though it was “later-term” abortion day, which is horrendous, and so hard witnessing all the extremely swollen bellies, we were able to witness God move in such a tremendous way in the heart of an abortion-bound mama!

She had arrived early in the morning, and had actually taken a brochure from one of our sidewalk counselors, but went inside the building anyway. While she remained inside for almost three hours, we continued to minister, pleading with all the other women coming and waiting for their abortions. Pleading with them to talk with us and to protect their precious little ones.

Suddenly, we noticed that one particular mama from early in the morning pulling out, but not without making sure to stop and talk with us, and looking so excited!

She had her window rolled down, and said these words with a smile on her face: "I've changed my mind. I left and I'm keeping my baby!" We asked her what changed her mind and she pointed to her mother sitting in the passenger seat and shared how her mom began to feel so uncomfortable inside of that place and wanted to get out of there (as she pointed

to the abortuary).

We talked with her quite a bit while tears of joy fell down her face; it was so beautiful! We then informed her that she could get a free sonogram right next door and encouraged her to go right then, which she did!

Before she left to go next door to the pregnancy center, Brittany, one of the counselors, asked if she could pray for her, and right away she said yes. How wonderful to pray for this mama, her baby who was now safe, and her rescuer mother!

God truly moved that afternoon, changing the heart of that mama and rescuing that little babe from the claws of abortion!

Yes, every child rescued from the slaughter at these abortuaries is truly a miracle, a life saved, a heart changed. Oh Hallelujah, for HE is great, and greatly to be praised!

2019, when taxpayers funded 4,463 abortions, but still represents the second-highest figure ever and a 30 percent rise since 2013. PP, however, saw a large increase

in 2020. It was reimbursed a record-high \$730,559 for a record-high 3,422 abortions. The group has increased its tax-funded abortion total for nine consecutive

years—a 296 percent jump since 2011.

Minnesota law prohibited public funding of elective abortions until a 1995 Minnesota Supreme Court decision, *Doe*

#### Sarah Stoesz

Sarah Stoesz, president and CEO of Planned Parenthood North Central States (PPNCS) since 2001, recently announced that she will be leaving the post this fall. PPNCS is based in St. Paul.

Under Stoesz's leadership, the number of babies killed every year by PPNCS in Minnesota has risen steadily, even though the overall number of annual abortions in the state has decreased during that time. Based on state health records, about 104,000 babies have been killed by PPNCS in Minnesota alone during Stoesz's tenure. And that doesn't include the many thousands more killed in the South Dakota, Iowa, and Nebraska PP abortion mills when they joined this affiliate under Stoesz's watch.

Stoesz is also involved in the leadership of Planned Parenthood on the national level. And she is a co-founder of Afaxys, a birth-control purchaser and supplier, and BRIDGE Health Partners, which provides administrative services to other PP affiliates nationwide.

In announcing her resignation from PPNCS, Stoesz said working there has been "the opportunity of a lifetime and the greatest joy I could have imagined." In a recent interview, she mentioned how proud she was of the organization's work in the political arena.

Pray that Stoesz would have the courage to leave her deep involvement in abortion now, repent and find healing and reconciliation in Christ.

*v. Gomez*, required such funding through Minnesota's Medicaid program. Since then, taxpayers have bankrolled close to 100,000 abortions at a cost of about \$29 million. A large body of research, including a literature review by the abortion-industry-aligned Guttmacher Institute, shows that public funding of abortion leads to significantly more overall abortions than would otherwise take place.

### PP Receives \$275 Million from Amazon Beneficiary

MacKenzie Scott, the ex-wife of Amazon founder Jeff Bezos, recently donated \$275 million to the abortion chain Planned Parenthood (PP), including \$20 million to Planned Parenthood North Central States (PPNCS), the affiliate based in St. Paul. PPNCS' CEO Sarah Stoesz (see page 6) was very grateful for the donation, particularly at this time. "Multiple states in the Midwest could lose access to abortion this summer," she said, "and we will be doing everything we can to make sure everyone gets the health care they need and deserve."

Ironically, upon sending in the donation, Ms. Scott said, "We are all human. And we all have enormous energy to devote to helping and protecting those we love."

to try to intercept the pregnant woman. As the sidewalk counselor reported: "I had told her we would be there waiting to talk with her at the sidewalk and asked her to make sure she came to talk with me before going in. She agreed but, thank the Lord, she did not show for that appointment."

Forward to mid-March when the sidewalk counselor saw the young woman and learned that she was 18 weeks pregnant at the time! The sidewalk counselor wrote, "Still trying to get her to go to Abria or other resource center but at least I know she is beautifully and visibly pregnant. Praise the Lord!"
