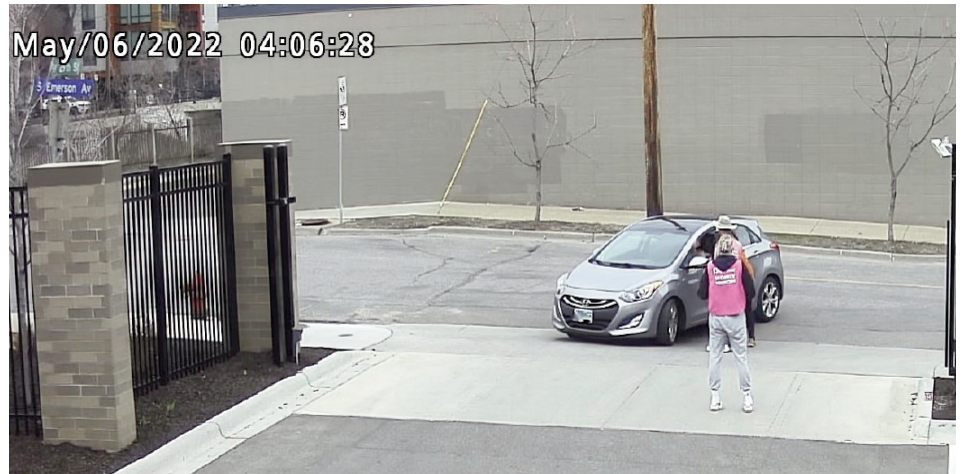
Minneapolis Restricts Free Speech Rights of Pro-Lifers

The Minneapolis City Council unanimously passed an ordinance November 17 to prohibit sidewalk counselors from approaching vehicles in the driveway area of the public sidewalk at the Uptown Minneapolis Planned Parenthood (PP). Additionally, anyone starting to cross PP's driveway on the public sidewalk must continue to walk on the public sidewalk to the end of PP's property without stopping.

All of this was based on claims of traffic safety and interference with vehicles entering PP, neither of which was evident in the footage from PP's security cam-

Tough Day, But We Persevere

PLAM Action presented its first "Life City" ordinance proposal to the City of Prinsburg, a small town southwest of Willmar on November 15. The ordinance can best be explained with the following scenario: right now in Minnesota, a school counselor can legally bring a student to an abortion clinic and bring her back to school, and her parents will never know. Under the proposed ordinance, her father could sue the counselor, the school, and the abortion clinic.

There are other scenarios, but the point of the Life City ordinances is to expose the abortion industry in Minnesota to civil action. It is similar to a successful model in Texas, Nebraska and other states. For Minnesota, because of court decisions, this is our only way to fight against the abortion industry to stop abortions across the state.

We have been working with the City of Prinsburg for several months behind the scenes. This presentation officially made the proposal public. Expectedly, there was a great deal of press attention. Also, Minnesota Attorney General Keith Ellison wrote a letter to Prinsburg telling them the action was "unconstitutional." AG Ellison had never even seen the ordinance proposal. He was simply trying to scare the city into submission.

The strategy was effective. Despite pleas to continue with the original plan of taking our time and building support in the community, the city council scheduled a special city council meeting for December 2, brought the ordinance proposal to a vote, and subsequently voted it down. They did this to "get the town out of the spotlight."

Prinsburg is a very good town of Christian faith. But the city council is acting in fear right now, so we have to take a step back. There certainly are lessons to



be learned and we will make adjustments. However, we are pressing forward in other communities. Our plans have not changed. Our mission remains the same. This is simply a reminder that the journey is going to be long and difficult. But our God reigns. His Will be done.

A quote from one of my favorite leaders, Winston Churchill, is, "Success is not final, failure is not fatal: it is the courage to continue that counts." It was a tough day, but we will persevere.

The Third Rail

With the fall of *Roe v. Wade* in June, the 2022 elections took a decidedly different tone from recent elections. Those campaigning on the pro-life side were admonished by party officials to stay away from the abortion “issue” instead of proclaiming their pro-life position. The admonition included stating that abortion was not on the ballot. For those advocating for the killing of defenseless children, it was pressing hard on the “extreme position” of their opponents to the point of making certain that abortion was indeed on the ballot.

After *Roe v. Wade* was decided in 1973 and the pro-life movement began to influence lawmakers and elections, political parties, for a couple decades, avoided directly speaking about abortion. Coded language was created to indicate to base voters that their candidate was with them on abortion. Abortion was called the “Third Rail” of politics, referencing the very dangerous electrified rail in commuter subways. One touch and you were done.

But in more recent years, and even in nationwide presidential elections, boldly proclaiming your position on abortion came into use. Most enlightening was the winning message of pro-life candidates when pointing out the radical position of the all-or-nothing abortion approach of their opponents. Pro-life candidates can

who advocate such extreme abortion positions. The reality is that, even in “blue” states, the vast majority of voters do not agree with unlimited abortion throughout pregnancy. But when there is no attempt to show that extreme position by a pro-life candidate who loses, the perception is that the radical pro-abortion view is a majority view. And it will be acted upon legislatively. That consequence may be deadly for the unborn, who are not a political issue but human beings exposed to the greatest injustice of our times.

Abortion can end, but it will take great, courageous action and ardent prayer.

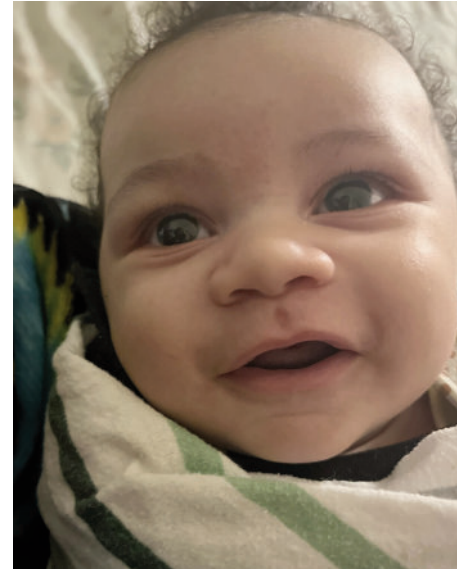

“Looking Forward to What Lies Ahead”

“I don’t mean to say that I have already achieved these things or that I have already reached perfection. But I press on to possess that perfection for which Christ Jesus first possessed me. No, dear brothers and sisters, I have not achieved it, but I focus on this one thing: forgetting the past and looking forward to what lies ahead, I press on to reach the end of the race and receive the heavenly prize for which God, through Christ Jesus, is calling us.”

- Phil. 3:12-14 (New Living Translation)

The Apostle Paul, with all he had been through toward the end of his ministry, admitted he had not reached perfection, but pressed on to complete the race and receive the heavenly prize.

It is imperative in these times that we not look back and gaze upon defeats or victories, but look forward. The mid-term elections (disappointing) and the *Dobbs* decision overturning *Roe* (a day of celebration) — both of these events pale against what lies ahead.

We know scripturally things will get worse. For the pro-life movement here in the Twin Cities, the Minneapolis City Council’s back-alley ordinance (see page 1), interfering with the ability of our sidewalk counselors to get lifesaving alternatives-to-abortion literature out is just one example.

The Minnesota Governorship, Attorney General and Secretary of State offices, and both the House and Senate are now controlled by the pro-abortion Democratic (DFL) party. These leaders do not care about the preborn and even less about you and me.

But we must look forward more than ever. The contrast of light standing in the gap for the preborn and the darkness of the abortion industry with the presence of Christians praying in front of these citadels of death is needed more than ever!

We know that ordinances, laws and regulations will increase and the media cannot always be relied upon to deal with us fairly. But if we press on to the end of the race we may see abortion become unthinkable, and therefore illegal in Minnesota in our lifetime.

We have another opportunity to

Since 2007, 40 Days for Life national/international has verified 22,829 preborn children saved from abortion, 132 abortion facilities permanently closed (including the dedicated abortion facility in HealthPartners’ Regions Hospital right here in St. Paul), 247 abortion workers quit, more than one million participants and 20,000 churches in 64 nations.

Our preborn brothers and sisters cannot wait for our individual schedules, elections, laws or any political candidate or personality. Weeping at the Abortuary, the Day Before Thanksgiving!

It was the day before Thanksgiving, and as usual, we were ministering at the local abortuary, crying out for the little ones scheduled to be slaughtered. We brought out a speaker and began to play worship music, entering into HIS presence amongst such evil!

It was busy, with many abortion-bound men and women hanging out front, many from different states who had driven so many miles to have their children killed before Thanksgiving. eras. We were not afforded an opportunity to comment before the city council.

Not surprisingly, this had been in the works for five months behind closed doors with the ordinance itself being written in collusion with PP officials.

We have been in consultation with the Thomas More Society and Life Legal Defense, pro-life legal advocacy groups, to determine whether we can take the City of Minneapolis to federal court for this blatant violation of our constitutional rights.

To be perfectly clear, had there been a shred of evidence that we interfere with access to this PP, both Minnesota and federal FACE (Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances) laws would have been invoked. It simply has not, and does not, happen.

But it is not we who are being harmed by this evil effort, it is the babies we seek to protect. We do this work for God and for His precious little ones and their moms and dads. And, in fact, despite the ordinance, God has given us opportunities to continue reaching out to the women driving in at this PP! Please join us out there to pray and to save lives! Abortions are committed on Mondays and Thursdays and we could really use your help so that ALL the abortion clients receive a message of help and hope so that they might change their minds.

The Minneapolis PP is the only location that is affected by this ordinance. But Planned Parenthood is most likely already colluding with the St. Paul City Council for a similar ordinance at their mega-abortion center (see volunteer request below). Please keep all of this in prayer.

out, "My baby, oh, my baby, why, oh why?"

The room was full of police officers standing by. We wrapped our arms around Brittany and wept with her. She asked me over and over, "Why did God take my baby?" All I could say was, "I don't know, but we do know he is with Jesus right now." In her grief she cried out to God to comfort her and then the room filled with the love of God. That's

the only way I can describe it. The love of God was heavy in the room. I said to Brittany, "Honey, Malachi means 'messenger of God', the message God is giving us through him is love."

Brittany continued to lament in agony, then, remarkably, she prayed, "Lord Jesus, comfort me and comfort everyone in this room because everyone is crying." Truly, the officers and others who came in were crying too.

A police chaplain came and gave Brittany very comforting words. God was very present with Brittany and all of us.

After the coroner left we were allowed to see Malachi. When it came my turn and I saw him just lying on the bed like a sleeping baby, I fell on my knees and remembered the words of Job, "The Lord gives and takes away, blessed be the Name of the Lord." As I spoke those words and thanked the Lord for Malachi's short life, other police officers were around watching. God was bringing glory to His name in this tragedy.

My daughter stayed with Brittany and

Is Your Doctor Involved in Abortions?

Does Your Doctor Prescribe Abortifacient Birth Control?

Ask your doctor if he/she does abortions or refers for them, or prescribes abortifacients such as the Pill, Ortho Evra (the "patch"), Depo-Provera (the "shot"), Nuva-Ring, the "morning-after pill," implants, or the IUD. All these methods (and others) can cause very early abortions by thinning the lining of the uterus so that if breakthrough ovulation occurs (which is possible) and a new life is conceived, the young human being may not be able to attach to the uterine lining and therefore he or she dies. Thank you for praying for Brittany. She reminded me that Judah means 'praise God' and says she is doing that and thankful to God for Malachi's life.

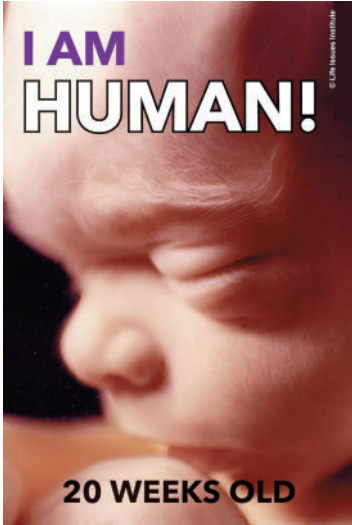
