Minneapolis to Pay More than \$450,000 in Fees and Costs Following Free Speech Violations

Editor's note — The following article is taken from a March 24 press release from the Thomas More Society.

Thomas More Society attorneys announced a \$450,000 attorneys' fees and costs award to the national public interest law firm, just agreed to by the City of Minneapolis, which adds onto an over \$6,000 costs judgment previously award-

ed by the court. Thomas More Society represented Pro-Life Action Ministries in a lawsuit challenging the city's unconstitutional buffer zone ordinance.

The ordinance, enacted in 2022, restricted the free speech rights of pro-life sidewalk counselors outside the City's Planned Parenthood abortion facility. Pro-Life Action Ministries, with the support of the Thomas More Society, filed suit in 2023, arguing that the law

violated their constitutional rights to free speech and freedom of religion. After nearly two years of hard-fought litigation, in December 2024, Thomas More Society attorneys secured entry of agreed judgments in the case. (See the December 2024 issue of Pro-Life Action News at www.plam.org/resources/) Minneapolis amended its ordinance to exclude Pro-Life Action Ministries' constitutionally

City of Minneapolis, United States District Court Case No. 23-cv-853, in the amount of \$450,000 made payable to plaintiffs' attorneys Thomas More Society, from Fund/Org. 06900 1500100 145240; and authorizes the City Attorney's Office to execute any documents necessary to effectuate this settlement.

protected activities, including sidewalk counseling, and agreed to cover attorneys' fees and costs incurred by Thomas More Society.

Peter Breen, Thomas More Society Executive Vice President & Head of Litigation, stated: "This is a total victory for free speech and the pro-life movement. The City of Minneapolis' capitulation and agreement to pay nearly a half-million dollars in fees and costs reflects the strength of our case and demonstrates the importance of vigorously defending fundamental freedoms in court. Politicians seeking to hinder and silence the efforts of pro-life sidewalk counselors should think twice—or it will cost them."

Brian Gibson, Chief Executive Officer of Pro-Life Action Ministries, added: "We are extremely grateful to the Thomas More Society legal team that won this decisive victory. Our restored ability to utilize our Constitutionally protected rights, offering help and hope to those with scheduled abortions at the Minneapolis Planned Parenthood, has already saved more babies' lives. The City of Minneapolis admitting to having violated

so many women going ahead with their scheduled abortions despite our pleas, offers of help and our prayers. Yes, we will have those who listen, say yes to the life within them, accept the help through the many amazing pregnancy resource centers, and show joyous gratitude for that baby's life. But those remain a minority of all those we reach out to, which is every single mom with a scheduled abortion, at least to the best of our ability.

Despite what difficulties there may be, as followers of Jesus Christ and filled with the Holy Spirit, our demeanor and attitude, our words and actions must

reflect that of the words of scripture in Galatians:

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such there is no law. And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit." (Gal. 5:22-25)

If we indeed are Christ's followers, if indeed we have been sealed with the Holy Spirit, then our response to any and all difficulties includes this fruit of the Spirit. Gaining the heart and mindset to have this become our natural response requires much prayer and purposeful fostering.

More Volunteers Needed — God Will Supply Time and Fortitude

More sidewalk ministry volunteers (prayer supporters and sidewalk counselors) are needed out on the sidewalks each week. We have a shortage of volunteers and typically have some shifts that lack prayer support, and our list of those who are able to sidewalk counsel on the sidewalks is low and changes weekly.

Although we are very grateful for the witness of so many of you who attend our large Good Friday and other prayer gatherings throughout the year, we are in great need of ongoing help on the sidewalks. We recognize how we can all become forgetful or wish to hide our conscience from the horror and injustice of abortion. Sometimes the big events will falsely placate our consciences. I was one of those people for many years.

We at Pro-Life Action Ministries believe no mother and father should enter a killing center without a last-moment offer of help from sidewalk counselors and no baby should die without the witness of people offering prayer out on the sidewalk in front of the building. We respect that not everyone can offer a weekly shift, given their family responsibilities

or their physical health, but we believe everyone who has the physical ability to come out should sacrifice regular time in prayer or as a sidewalk counselor outside of the place where the destruction of innocent human life is happening.

The late Bro. Michael Gaworski, fbp, co-founder of Pro-Life Action Ministries, said, “If we are truly pro-life, if we are truly Christian, and you and I really, truly believe that what is going on inside of these abortion chambers is the killing of our unborn brothers and sisters, then you and I aren’t going to let one calendar month go by without spending at least two hours at the scene of the crime.”

Abby Johnson, a former killing center director, recently said, “Action is required from the pro-life movement, from the conservative movement. Armchair action is no longer good enough. We must take our prayer to the streets. We must go and peacefully and prayerfully contend for the souls, for the lives of those who are being snuffed out by abortion and we must contend for the souls who are, quite honestly, on a potential path to hell because of their involvement in the abortion industry.”

Below is the current list of killing centers in the Twin Cities where we need your presence. Even if you cannot come

during the hours that we are scheduling volunteers, please go there sometime when you can to pray, before or after work, or weekend day, and bring your friends.

Ask yourself the hard questions: “When will I commit to going out to witness for the innocent ones?” If you don’t think you can, look into your heart and ask, “Why can’t I go?” Do you need time? Ask God for it. Do you need courage? Ask God for it. Remember that in the Bible, God tells us 365 times, “Be Not Afraid!”

God will supply the time and fortitude for the task. We provide the training, materials and support for volunteers. Great is our reward in heaven for every offering we give to the least of these.

our rights should serve as a warning to other cities looking to enact similar ordinances.”

Editor’s note — In a related matter, the U.S. Supreme Court recently declined to hear a “buffer zone” case from Carbondale, Ill., that pro-lifers were hoping could lead to the overturning of Hill v. Colorado, in which the Supreme Court in 2000 had upheld restrictive buffer zones. But in the 2014 McCullen case, the Supreme Court struck down a Massachusetts law that created 35-foot buffer zones around medical facilities, and a passage in the 2022 Dobbs decision called the Hill decision into question.

Justice Clarence Thomas dissented in the recent decision not to hear the Carbondale case, stating that “Hill has been seriously undermined, if not completely eroded, and our refusal to provide clarity is an abdication of our judicial

duty. ‘We are responsible for the confusion among the lower courts, and it is our job to fix it.’ Gee, 586 U. S., at 1059 (opinion of THOMAS, J.). I would have taken this opportunity to explicitly overrule Hill. For now, we leave lower courts to sort out what, if anything, is left of Hill’s reasoning, all while constitutional rights hang in the balance.” Justice Samuel Alito said he also would have heard the case, even with the city quickly repealing the law shortly before the petition to the Supreme Court was filed.

Overturing Hill could prevent cities like Minneapolis from trying to enact their own buffer zone laws but it seems abortion supporters are anxious to avoid a case being heard by the Supreme Court. A previous Westchester County, N.Y. buffer zone ordinance was repealed as it became clear pro-lifers were hoping to appeal that one to the Supreme Court.

Recent Pro-Life Action Ministries Events

Jericho March — Duluth

On a cold and icy March 29, 35 pro-lifers came to pray outside the Building for Women (photo, right), which houses the WE Health abortion facility. We marched around the block and the abortion center seven times, praying for the end of abortion in Duluth and in Minnesota. At each stop on the way around, Director Tom Schaer led us in scripture (that we read out loud in unison - very powerful) and a song. We are planning to have another Jericho March the first weekend of June, with the hope for better weather and a bigger turnout like we had in the past two years.

“Defund Planned Parenthood” Protest — Central Florida

The Central Florida branch of Pro-Life Action Ministries participated in a nationwide protest against Planned Parenthood (PP) on April 2, the day the U.S. Supreme Court heard oral arguments in the case of *Medina v. Planned Parenthood South Atlantic*. They got much visibility by lining the very busy highway in front of Planned Parenthood UCF in Orlando. Michele Herzog, Central Florida Branch Manager, reports that during the picket, “I had the opportunity to speak with two young women who were going into PP. One of them called our ministry line later in the afternoon for help!” The nationwide protests were promoted by Pro-Life Action League and Citizens for a Pro-life Society.

In its latest annual report, PP reported receiving nearly \$700 million dollars in taxpayer funds as it killed 392,715 unborn babies. In *Medina*, the U.S. Supreme Court will decide if South Carolina and other pro-life states can determine that PP is not qualified to be a Medicaid provider. The vast majority of PP’s federal tax-funding is through the Medicaid program.



Jericho March — St. Paul

About 65 people participated in the closing of our seven-day Jericho March around Planned Parenthood (PP) in St. Paul on April 13. (This was also the closing of our Lenten 40 Days for Life Campaign.) After marching around PP once each of the previous six days, we marched around six times in silent prayer on the seventh day and then the last time around, three attendees blew shofars and we praised God with loud acclamations. This annual event is based on the story in the book of Joshua.

Please pray for the woman who came to the door of PP during the last day of our Jericho March. PP is closed on Sundays, so two sidewalk counselors (one Spanish-speaking) were able to talk with her without interference. She didn’t know yet if she is pregnant, but if so, she was considering abortion. The sidewalk counselors were able to give her hope, an 8-week fetal model and Spanish literature, as well as show her where Abria, the nearby pregnancy resource center, is.



Babies Saved

We have also recently had many "hopeful" baby saved situations, including during 40 Days for Life outside the St. Paul PP, as well as situations at the Brooklyn Park and Uptown PPs, and in Moorhead.

Moorhead's First Baby Saved for 2025!

On April 9, a woman arrived at the Red River Women's Clinic, but stated that she was looking for a friend's house, that she was not there for an abortion. Sidewalk counselor Roxane explained why they were there in case she was not telling the truth. She kept driving ahead, but it's a dead end, except for a side street.

The other pro-lifers left, and Roxane and Ann were heavily outnumbered by many pro-abortion escorts. They were about to pray the Divine Mercy chaplet when the woman parked on the curb behind them, got out, and said, "I lied. I was here to get an abortion, but I can't do it. I'm not going to do it." Roxane and Ann were elated, and gave the woman hugs, encouragement, and affirmation, and directed her to the Women's Care Center, a pregnancy resource center. The woman was very happy and relieved, even saying, "What would I have done if you weren't here? I'm so glad you were here!" She got very excited about telling her husband that he is going to be a dad again. He had refused to drive her to the abortion facility, so he too would be relieved that she changed her mind.

"It was quite a moment of beautiful victory," wrote Roxane, "especially after the escorts had just used a long hose to spray off some beautiful chalk messages and drawings that a group of young peo-

ple from Grand Forks had just drawn there a short time earlier. It was a true triumph, and we are so grateful for this mom."

Another Baby Saved in Central Florida!

Pro-Life Actions of the New Trump Administration

Just three months into his second term, Donald Trump has taken many pro-life actions, most of which rescinded pro-abortion actions taken by Joe Biden. Here is a list of some of Trump's actions:

* Pardoned 23 peaceful pro-lifers convicted during the Biden administration, many of whom received severe sentences for their participation in peaceful sit-ins meant to save the lives of unborn babies.

* Announced plans to limit enforcement of the Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances (FACE) Act, which has been weaponized against pro-lifers and rarely used against people who have vandalized churches or pregnancy resource centers.

* Froze \$20 million in federal family planning funds to 16 Title X recipients, including Planned Parenthood North Central States, based in St. Paul, as he

investigates possible use of the money to fund diversity, equity and inclusion (DEI) programs in violation of his executive orders, and because PP "overtly encourages illegal aliens to receive care."

* Appointed *many* pro-life, Christian men and women to prominent positions in his administration.

Pray for . . .

Margaret Carpenter

Margaret Daley Carpenter is an abortionist with online abortion pill suppliers based in New York. She was licensed in Minnesota during all of 2024, presumably so that she could kill unborn babies in our state by prescribing and mailing abortion pills.

Carpenter was recently indicted in Louisiana where she was not licensed. She had sent the abortion pill to a woman who then coerced her minor daughter to take it though the girl wanted to keep her baby. She was apparently alone when she took the abortion pill and ended up in the emergency room with complications. The mother has also been indicted. Abortion supporters, including New York Gov. Kathy Hochul, defended the abortionist, not the baby who was killed nor the girl who was harmed!

Carpenter was also recently sued by the state of Texas after she sent a woman in that state the abortion pill in violation of several Texas laws, including not having a medical license in that state. That woman also was treated for complications (hemorrhaging). A Texas judge has ordered Carpenter to stop prescribing the abortion pill to Texas residents and to pay a \$100,000 fine.

Please pray that these legal consequences would cause Carpenter to stop killing babies and hurting women across the country, and more important, that she would repent of her involvement in abortion and turn to Christ.

Is Your Doctor Involved in Abortions? Does Your Doctor Prescribe Abortifacient Birth Control?

Ask your doctor if he/she does abortions or refers for them, or prescribes abortifacients such as the Pill, Ortho Evra (the "patch"), Depo-Provera (the "shot"), Nuva-Ring, the "morning-after pill," implants, or the IUD. All these methods (and others) can cause very early abortions by thinning the lining of the uterus so that if breakthrough ovulation occurs (which is possible) and a new life is conceived, the young human being may not be able to attach to the uterine lining and therefore he or she dies. * Reinstated and expanded the "Protecting Life in Global Health Assistance" policy ("Mexico City" policy), which bans American tax dollars to groups that promote or provide abortions overseas. International Planned Parenthood Federation alone estimated a \$100 million loss due to this policy.

* Issued an executive order enforcing the Hyde Amendment, which prohibits federal funding of elective abortions in the U.S. and which has saved more than an estimated 2.5 million lives since 1977.

* Stopped the Biden administration's use of taxpayer funds to subsidize abortions for military personnel and their dependents.

* Withdrew from the pro-abortion World Health Organization (WHO) and dismantled the US Agency for International Development (USAID), which impacts foreign countries' efforts to protect unborn children.

* Renewed our nation's commitment to the Geneva Consensus Declaration which confirms that there is no international right to abortion.

* On his first day in office, disabled a website the Biden administration had created to promote abortion.

* Endorsed a Congressional bill that would protect babies who survive abortions.

* Spoke via a video message to the national March for Life in January. Vice President J.D. Vance encouraged the marchers in person.

* In an executive order which proclaimed that there are only two sexes, Trump stated that sex "is determined genetically at conception."

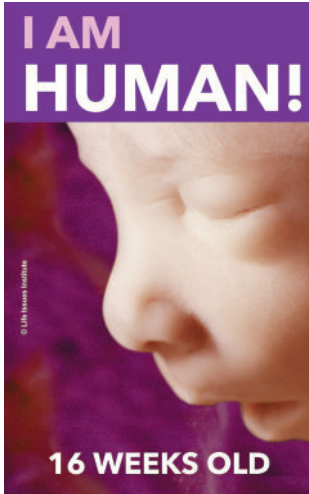
